from Lynnhaven River Now

“Dear CHSCA Members,

On behalf of Lynnhaven River NOW, we sincerely thank you for your donation of \$25. Donations are integral to carrying out our mission.

Member donations give us the resources to improve water quality and educate watershed residents about water quality problems and solutions. Eleven year ago, when Lynnhaven river NOW was launched, only 1% of the river was open to shellfish harvesting. Thanks to you, this year almost half of the river meets the rigorous water quality standard to be open for shellfish harvesting, six commercial oyster companies are working in the Lynnhaven and we have sixty-three acres of sanctuary oyster reef.

Through School and Citizen Oyster Gardening Programs, we were able to put 466,000 reproductive oysters on Lynnhaven sanctuary reefs this past year. We also installed our first oyster castles, which have already become thriving oyster colonies. They oysters reproduce, filter and continue to make a significant contribution to a cleaner and healthier river.
