# 25 MPH

Summer is nearly upon us here in Cape Henry Shores. On June 18th school will be out and you should notice more children riding bikes on the streets, pets being walked and countless pedestrians heading to the beach to cool off. Shore Drive is being RADAR monitored by the Virginia Beach Police Department since the speed limit has been lowered to 35 MPH. Please carefully monitor your speed not only on Shore Drive, but as well in our neighborhood. The limit within the neighborhood is 25 MPH. It can not be stressed enough to maintain the speed limit. Additional activity and additional cars parked along street curbs decrease visibility for both driver and pedestrians. We must police ourselves within CHS to keep our streets safe.

**"What Can You Do To  
Preserve Our Precious  
Water Resources?!"**

By reducing the amount of water pumped from wells, CHSCA residents can help protect groundwater from saltwater intrusion.

- Turn off irrigation systems and sprinklers when rain has occurred or is in the forecast.
- Avoid over-irrigating. Most lawns only need about one inch of water per week during the growing season.
- Check your irrigation system control settings. Water early in the morning to reduce evaporation rates.
- Use weather monitoring or soil-moisture monitoring devices to automatically cease irrigation on rainy days.
- Landscape with drought-tolerant native plants. Grass requires more water than native plants or mulched gardens.
- Install rainwater-collection systems or rain barrels with screened lids to collect and use roof runoff.
- Find and fix leaking outdoor faucets and hoses.
- Wash cars on grass or gravel so water can soak back into the ground."

## Bicycle Laws and Safety



### BICYCLES HAVE A RIGHT TO USE THE ROADWAYS...

State Code 46.2-800 states that a bicycle shall be a vehicle while operated on any street...

#### THEREFORE:

Bicyclists **MUST** follow traffic rules and laws (stop signs, traffic signals, etc)

#### AND:

Cars **MUST** allow the opportunity for them to do so

### PASSING BICYCLES SAFELY

Other vehicles **MUST** give proper clearance when passing bicycles on any street.

State Code 46.2-839 states that any vehicle overtaking (passing) a bicycle shall pass at a reasonable speed & at least **TWO FEET** to the left of the bicycle

### BICYCLE HELMETS

City Code 7-50 states that all bicyclists age 14 & under **MUST** wear a helmet.

While ages 15 & above are not required to wear helmets, the Virginia Beach Police Department strongly encourages all bicyclists to wear a helmet.

### LIGHTS REQUIRED AT NIGHT

State Code 46.2-1015 requires that all bicycles operated at night must have a white headlight and red taillight.

### PROPER LANE USAGE

State Code 46.2-905 requires that bicycles shall not ride more than two abreast. If this impedes traffic flow, bicycles must ride single file. Bicycles shall use only one lane of a street, no matter how many are available.
